Conditions of entry

Interstate travellers to WA are subject to:



You will need a G2G PASS to enter Western Australia



Border checkpoints for all arrivals



Health screenings and temperature checks on arrival



Perth Airport COVID-19 test if required

Conditions of quarantine differ for arrivals from:

Very low risk states and territories

Low risk states and territories
includes 14 days self-quarantine and a COVID-19 test

Medium risk states and territories
not permitted to enter WA without an exemption

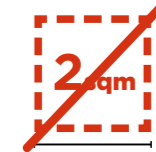

WA's border controls will be considered based on expert health advice, taking into account infection rates over east.



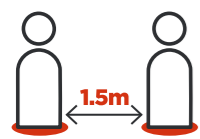
Removal of 2sqm rule for all
